# Exhibiting VAPA Artist: Holly Spruck

Holly is a narrative oil painter working in Charlotte, NC since 2002.
Born and raised in New York, she attended College in New Hampshire, where she earned a degree in Art Education with a minor in Painting.
From 1996 to 2002, Holly lived in the Czech Republic and taught art at the International School of Prague and pursued her painting career. While in Prague, Holly hosted four solo exhibitions, two selling out on opening night. ## Director's Note

The original 1968 Off-Broadway production of *Jacques Brel Is Alive and Well and Living in Paris* ran for four years and spawned international and regional productions, as well as a West End production and Off-Broadway revival. In April 1973, a revival of the show opened in the State Theatre Lobby of Playhouse Square in Cleveland, Ohio. Though booked for a few weeks, this now-legendary production proved so popular it ran for an astonishing two-and-a-half years, and rallied community support around the idea of saving historic theaters and revitalizing downtown Cleveland.

Director/Producer Anne Lambert saw that Cleveland production of *Jacques Brel Is Alive and Well and Living in Paris* several times in the 1970s with her actor father Victor Lambert and her sister Susan Lambert Hatem, now a producer, playwright, and podcast host ("80s TV Ladies") with whom Anne frequently collaborates. Anne and Susan grew up loving the show and Jacques Brel's music. Anne has been thinking about this project for several years, and was thrilled to receive a Cultural Vision Grant from the Arts & Science Council so she could produce and direct this show in 2023. She was also thrilled to be able to cast four of her favorite performers in Charlotte for the show, and to assemble a dream production team to transform the COB black box theater space into a slightly seedy cabaret circa 1973, and to help make this project a reality. #### About Anne Lambert & Charlotte's Off-Broadway

Under the banner Charlotte's Off-Broadway, Anne Lambert and her artistic collaborators produce projects that portray authentic female experiences, dramatize questions of social injustice and inequality, and illuminate the role women can play to advance socially progressive, transformative possibilities and solutions to enduring questions of gender privilege and bias. COB entertains audiences with provocative, innovative, and contemporary work.

Anne has been producing, directing, and acting in professional theatrical work in Charlotte since 1998. Recent shows includes: THUMBS (dir. Brian Lafontaine) in October 2022 at the COB black box space at the VAPA Center, SHE KILLS MONSTERS (dir. Sheri Marvin) in April 2022 and MY DINNER WITH ANDREA (dir. Marla Brown) in November 2021 at the Arts Factory in Charlotte, NC; CONFIDENCE (and THE SPEECH) as an AEA Showcase production (dir. Hannah Ryan) at Theatre Row in New York City in November 2019 and at the Duke Energy Theater (dir. Anne Lambert) in Charlotte, NC in September 2018; EXIT, PURSUED BY A BEAR (dir. Anne Lambert) in February 2019 and BARBECUE APOCALYPSE (dir. Anne Lambert) in May 2018 at the Warehouse PAC in Cornelius, NC; and THREE DAYS OF RAIN (dir. Paige Johnston Thomas) at the Duke Energy Theater in Spirit Square in December 2017.

Anne is also a co-founder of and producer for Chickspeare, Charlotte's allfemale Shakespeare company, which recently celebrated its 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary. She is also a member of a recently formed cooperative of diverse artists working with Mecklenburg County to transform an underutilized county building into the Visual and Performing Arts Center. Located on N. Tryon Street, the VAPA Center is a mecca for arts and live entertainment in the heart of downtown Charlotte featuring 5 galleries, 2-3 theater venues, rehearsal space, practice space, and art studios for individual artists.
